The collection

duVisst (inspiration bevisst, Norwegian for deliberate) is the furniture design workshop of David Wildman. David explores the new design language for furniture and décor that emerges from the synergy of traditional furniture craft and modern fabrication methods. Through a deliberate design-driven process, David contemplates how a piece of furniture interacts with a space and its users. The result is a collection that engages the senses with texture, pattern, scale, balance.



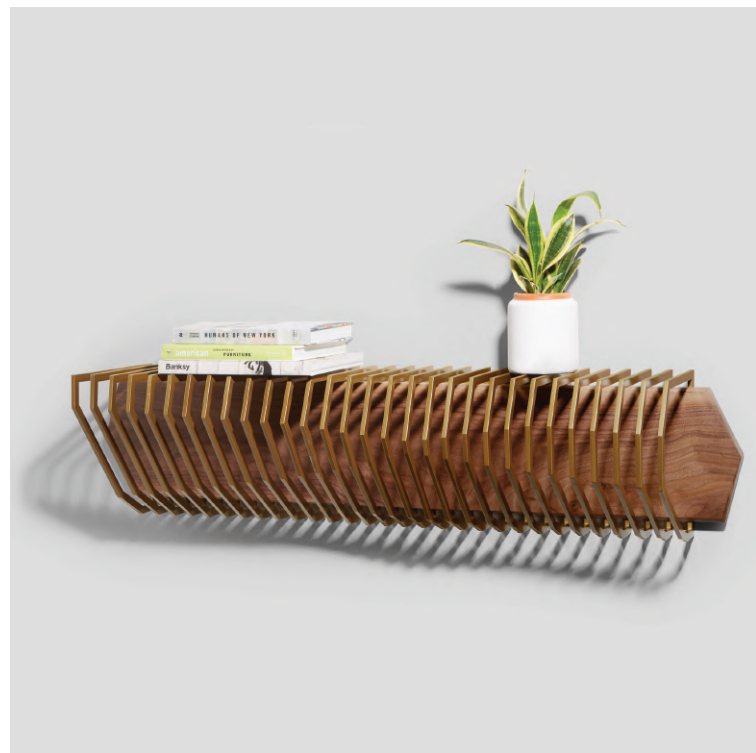


Lode Shelf



Inspired by geologic formations found in nature, the Lode Shelf is meant to capture the essence of the Basalt Cliffs of Iceland. The piece conveys delicate airiness, which is cleverly juxtaposed by the iron pyrite formations and the crystalline geode structure. The shelf allows light to shine through its individual ribs, creating a brilliant kaleidoscopic pattern of shadows. Depending on the angle, the appearance of the

Lode shelf changes profoundly and can appear solid or translucent. The shelf is masterfully engineered from individually cut pieces of aluminum with a stunning brass finish, and the base is constructed from an air-dried Walnut lumber with a hand rubbed polyurethane finish. The Lode shelf is also available in laser cut Baltic Birch plywood, stained with a dark walnut finish, and with a Hard Maple base.





Cooper Cabinet



The Cooper cabinet blends natural elements of wood with a man-made texture to create a dynamic piece that exudes harmony and contrast. The figured white oak veneer cabinet beautifully frames the embellished doors, which have a three-dimensional pattern engraved into the wood. Ebonized and cerused oak doors offers a sharp contrast against the natural white oak sides, creating an alluring focal point. The square-shaped mitered hard edges of the cabinet is balanced by the circular pattern of the doors, which all comes together beautifully by the solid oak handles and textured surface of the piece. The curved base with natural white oak offers movement and texture, solidifying the cohesion between the contrasting elements that is beautifully exemplified in the entire piece.





Side Table 1 (ST-1)



The ST-1 is a minimalistic side table that embraces an unconventional perspective regarding table design and how instability can be perceived from something that is stable. With only two legs, the table does seem to defy gravity and from some angles, the table has an almost Escher like appearance. This table merges both traditional craft joinery and hand work with modern fabrication and the result is sleek and modern. Available in both American Ash and Black Walnut. Finished by hand with a rubbed polyurethane





Side Table 2 (ST-2)



The modern elegance of the ST-2 can be perceived at any angle. The concept for the table came about by questioning a standard archetype for tables. The result was a design that is both bold and provocative. The table merges East Indian Rosewood veneer, Brass coated steel, and thick acrylic in a way that is not traditionally seen but also leaves no doubt as to its function. The rectilinear design evokes both architectural and sculptural sentiments while maintaining an understated grace and sophistication.



Axia Mirror



With its dramatic frame and undulating texture, the Axia Mirror makes a statement in any room. Constructed of solid hardwood, the scalloped frame is lacquered with meticulous gold leaf application. The piece adds modernity and sophistication to residential and commercial spaces, and is expertly designed to last for generations.



Treg Tray



The Treg Tray blends luxury bespoke design with soft minimalist lines, for a timeless piece that can last for generations. The tray features solid ebonized white oak with a cerused finish, and its textured grid adds visual interest and sophistication.



Casa Organizer



The Casa Organizer is the ultimate luxury desk accessory, featuring laminated cork and walnut layers. The handmade piece is designed to hold cards, pens, and pencils and offers a refined touch for any office setting.

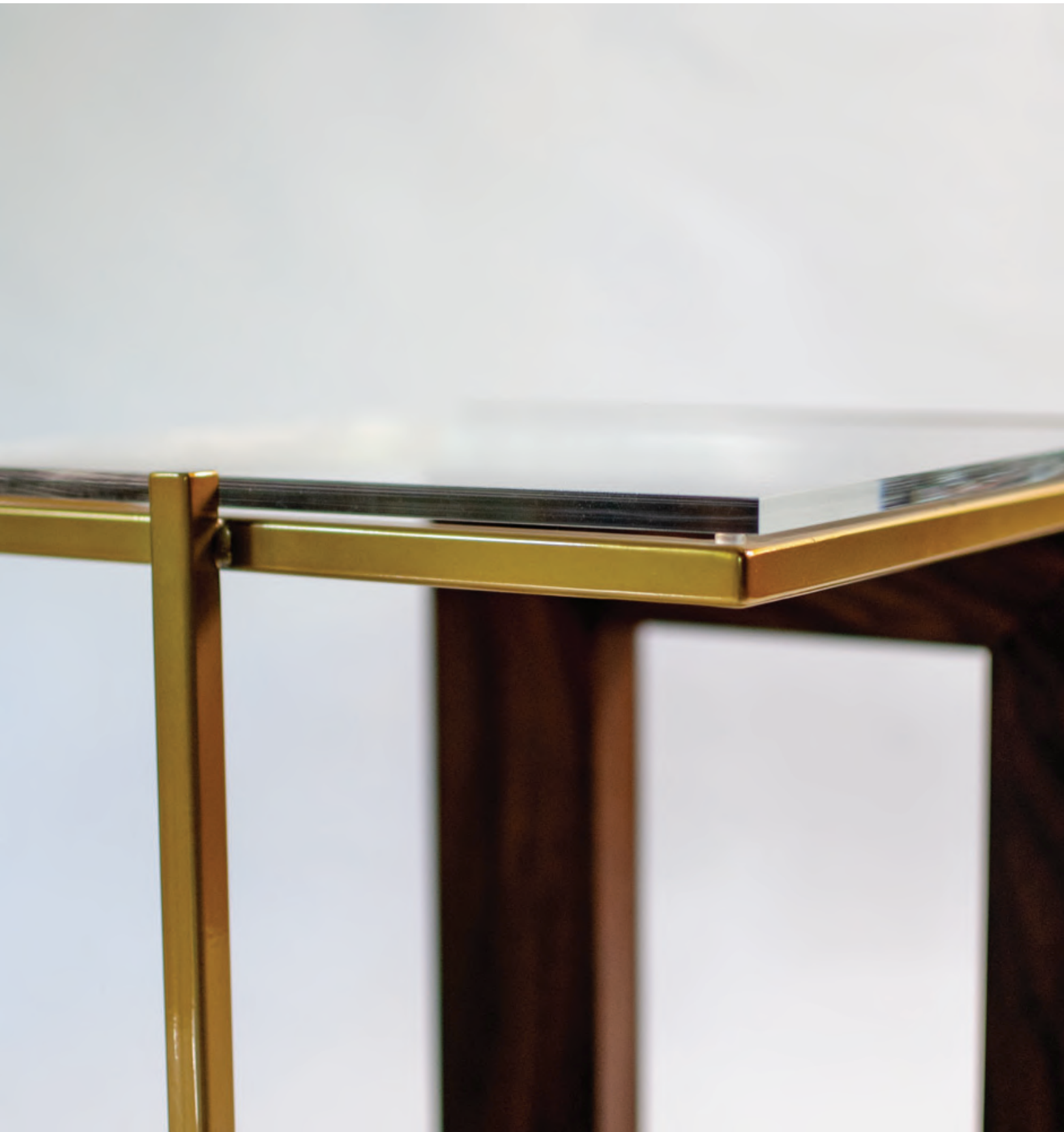


OHV Cabinet



The OHV Cabinet merges contemporary and Art Deco influences to create a magnificent piece that offers functionality and high-end design. The subtractive space in the center of the piece showcases movement and draws the eye to the central display space. The piece features exotic luxury materials including a superior grade of Walnut veneer and figured Anigre veneer. The pedestal is a brass coated finish that perfectly complements the wood cabinet, resulting in a timeless heirloom piece that is designed to last for generations.
